COMMANDANT'S DIRECTIVE

Directive No. 14-2

Prescribed Uniform for Detachment Commandants  
Promulgated July 7th, 2014

At all Department Conferences and Conventions, Business Meetings, it is directed that all Detachment Commandants or their representative wear the Uniform of the Day.

The Uniform of the Day shall be the Undress Uniform of the Marine Corps League. The undress uniform of the MCL, as stated in the National By Laws Enclosure Three, Section UNIFORMS MALE, UNDRESS, is as follows: Standard MCL cover, white shirt (Pilot), (with MCL or DOD ribbons), MODD Tag, blue dress trousers with NCO red stripe, Marine Corps khaki web belt with brass buckle, with black socks and black shined plain toe shoes; or optional black trousers with black belt, with black socks, and black shined plain toe shoes.)

This directive will be in effect forthwith.
